Host School Athletic Directors must contact the AIA immediately following the game to ensure proper posting of the AIA State Tournament Results.

RULES

Rules shall be those of the current National Federation Softball Rule Book, the AIA Constitution and Bylaws and these tournament instructions.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

State Tournament Qualifying:

6A, 5A, (16 team bracket): In order to qualify, a school must have scheduled a minimum of 14 games. Teams ranked No. 1 through No. 8 will earn an automatic bid to the state tournament. The conference play-in tournament will match teams ranked No. 9 through No. 24. Teams ranked No. 1 through No. 8, along with the eight winning teams from the conference play-in tournament, will make up the 16 team state tournament. The state tournament bracket will be seeded according to overall ranking of the 16 teams. The state tournament will be double elimination with a single game championship.

- 6A, 5A: Teams ranked No. 1 to 8 and eight (8) conference play-in winners

4A (16 team bracket): In order to qualify, a school must have scheduled a minimum of 14 games. Based on region standings, the top team in each region will earn an automatic bid at minimum to the conference play-in tournament. The conference play-in tournament will match up teams ranked No. 9 through No. 24. In addition, any region champ in the play-in tournament will be reseeded to be at minimum a No. 16 seed to be guaranteed a home game. Teams ranked No. 1 through No. 8, along with the eight winning teams from the conference play-in tournament, will make up the 16 team state tournament. The state tournament bracket will be seeded according to overall rankings of the 16 teams. The state tournament will be double elimination with a single game championship.

- 4A: Teams ranked No. 1 to 8 and eight (8) conference play-in winners

3A (16 team bracket): In order to qualify, a school must have scheduled a minimum of 14 games. Based on region standings, the top team in each region will earn an automatic bid at minimum to the conference play-in tournament. The conference play-in tournament will match up teams ranked No.9 through No. 24. Teams ranked No. 1 through No 8, along with the eight winning teams from the conference play-in tournament, will make up the 16 team state tournament. The state tournament bracket will be seeded according to overall rankings of the 16 teams. The state tournament will consist of four rounds and will be single elimination.

- 3A: Teams ranked No. 1 to 8 and eight (8) conference play-in winners

2A (16 team bracket): In order to qualify, a school must have scheduled a minimum of 14 games. Based on region standings or the region tournament (as determined by the region), the top two (2) teams in each region will earn an automatic bid to the conference play-in tournament. The conference play-in tournament will match up teams ranked No. 9 through No. 24. Teams ranked No. 1 through No. 8, along with the eight winning teams from the conference play-in tournament, will make up the 16 – team state tournament. The state tournament bracket will be seeded according to the overall ranking of the 16 teams, and will consist of four rounds and will be single elimination.

- 2A: Eight (8) automatic bids, Eight (8) at-large qualifiers based on ranking

1A (16 team bracket): In order to qualify, a school must have scheduled a minimum of 14 games. Based on region standings, the top two teams in each region will earn an automatic bid to the state tournament. The state tournament bracket will be seeded according to overall ranking of the 16 teams. The state tournament will consist of four rounds and will be single elimination.

- 1A: Ten (10) automatic bids, six (6) at-large qualifiers based on ranking

Dugouts (At Neutral Sites)

- Home team shall be on the side of third base. Visiting team shall be on the side of first base.

Batting Practice

- There is no batting practice at Rose Mofford, however the batting cages will be available at ASU – Farrington Stadium. Just prior to game time, warm-ups may take place on the outfield warning track of the assigned diamonds and shall be limited to whiffle-balls and soft toss into nets.

Warm-ups (At Neutral Sites)

- Each team shall have seven (7) minutes for warm-ups provided the games are running on time; the home team will be first. When the City of Phoenix staff are lining and dragging the field it is expected that the teams will honor the request to not throw or hit balls that may have the potential of hitting a city employee.

Ice and Sport Drink

- Each school is responsible for "injury treatment ice", water cooler and cups at games played at high school sites.
- Coolers (for water and sport drink) and cups will be provided at all neutral game sites.

Game Balls

- Official AIA softball is the Wilson Fast Pitch SST (A9011BSST) and must be used at all AIA State Tournament games.

SCORE BOOK

The official score book will be that of the **HOME** team.

RULES:

Official rules for girls' softball shall be those published in the current edition of the National Federation Softball Rules Book.

COACHING ATTIRE

The National Federation rule on coaching attire shall be applied to all coaches. Any time a coach is in live-ball area to confer with players or an umpire, or to occupy a coach's box, the coach shall be attired in school uniform or jersey/coaching shirt with coaching shorts/slacks or warm-up suits (including fleece worm ups) in school colors or colors of khaki, black, white or gray. Cut offs or any type of jeans are prohibited. Jackets are not considered part of the coach's uniform. See National Federation Softball Rules, 3- 5- 3.

TEN RUN RULE

A softball game shall end any time after five (5) innings, or after four and one-half (4 ½) innings when a team is ten (10) or more runs behind and has completed its turn at bat.

ROSE MOFFORD SOFTBALL COMPLEX – ARRIVAL OF TEAMS

Teams arriving in buses or vans need to drop-off players and coaches at the NORTH entrance gate. Drivers and/or coaches need to proceed to the western most area of the parking lot to be directed to their parking area. Teams arriving at any other gate will be directed to the North entrance gate. Please park buses at the west end of the parking lot. The parking lot will fill up so have the buses park as close to the curb as possible. If the bus parking space is filled you will be directed across 25th Avenue to Mountain View Street.

The City of Phoenix has taken out most of the grand stand seating at Rose Mofford Sports Complex for safety and maintenance reasons. Their long range plan is to have new shaded bleacher seating, but no timeline has been established for this project. In the meantime please make your teams fans aware that it is recommended that fans bring their own portable seating (lawn chairs). If portable shades structures are set up we ask that you do not block anyone else's ability to see the softball game!

FAN PARKING

Please park east of 25th Avenue in the **Rose Mofford Softball Complex** until the parking lot is full. The over full parking will be at the Black Canyon Conference Center and along West Mountain View Street. Do not park in the Sanford Brown College or the Corporate Center Property parking lots on weekdays or you may be subject to being towed. Those parking lots will be available for weekend parking only.
